DERMINATION AND FINDINGS

DOC Deviation from the Federal Acquisition Regulation Regarding Customary Progress Payment Rates Based on Costs Procurement Memorandum 2020-06

Findings:

- The Civilian Agency Acquisition Council (CAAC) issued CAAC Letter 2020-03 <u>https://www.acquisition.gov/sites/default/files/page_file_uploads/CAAC-Letter-2020-03.pdf</u> authorizing and encouraging agencies to issue class deviations to increase the customary progress payment rates based on costs at Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) 32.501-1 in response to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) national emergency.
- CAAC Letter 2020-03 serves as consultation in accordance with FAR 1.4040 by allowing agencies to authorize a class deviation immediately and to consider cancelling the deviation after the COVID-19 emergency passes.

Discussion:

The deviation revises FAR Parts 32 and 52 and increases the progress payment rates based on costs at FAR 32.501-1 from 80 to 90 percent for large business concerns and from 85 to 95 percent for small business concerns.

Determination:

It is hereby determined to be in the best interest of the government to increase the customary progress payment rates in support of the COVID-19 emergency and approve this class deviation. This class deviation is effective upon the date of signature and will remain in effect until cancelled.
