SUBJECT: Protests, Lawsuits and Appeals Notification

Background

In order to respond timely to inquiries received from Departmental Management regarding acquisition-related issues, it is important that the Office of Acquisition Management (OAM) is kept well informed of protests or lawsuits filed against the Department of Commerce (DOC) in relation to contract actions.

Purpose

The purpose of this Procurement Memorandum is to establish policy requiring Contracting Officers to provide notification to OAM of all protests or lawsuits relating to contract actions filed against the Department.

Applicability

This policy applies to all protests, lawsuits and appeals regarding a DOC contractual action.

Required Actions

Contracting Officers shall notify OAM of all protests, lawsuits, or appeals filed relating to a DOC contract action within one business day from receipt of such notification. Contracting Officers shall also provide OAM a copy of responses to such protests/lawsuits within one week after responses are submitted. A copy of all protests or lawsuit filings and responses shall be forwarded to the following office:
