The Business Applications Solution (BAS) project is a Department of Commerce modernization initiative to deploy an intergrated suite of financial and business management applications in support of the mission.

The Secretary of Commerce identified BAS as one of the top Departmental priorities. The objectives include implementing and integrating a suite of commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) business systems, enterprise data warehouse (EDW) and business intelligence (BI) reporting solution, and system interfaces in a hosted environment. The BAS Project will continue the ongoing emphasis on achieving organizational excellence and outstanding customer service for the Department.
