SUBJECT: DOL/OFCCP Temporary Waiver for Certain FAR Clauses
(Hurricane Michael)

Background

In light of the devastation created by Hurricane Michael, the U.S. Department of Labor's Office of Federal Contract Compliance Programs (OFCCP) has issued a temporary exemption from certain federal contracting Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) requirements.

Policy

The Hurricane Michael exemption period runs from October 11, 2018 to January 11, 2019. This exemption might be extended by OFCCP. For the period of the exemption, new Federal contracts to provide Hurricane Michael relief efforts should contain a provision exempting the contractor from having to develop written affirmative action programs as required by Executive Order 11246; the Vietnam Era Veterans Readjustment Assistance Act; and Section 503 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended.

Required Action

Pursuant to the OFCCP October 11, 2018 memorandum, available at <https://www.dol.gov/ofccp/Hurricane/HurricaneMichaelExemptionMemoFEDQA508.pdf>, when agencies enter into contracts which specifically provide relief for Hurricane Michael, the contracts are required to contain FAR clause 52.222-26, 52.222-35 and/or 52.222-36. The agencies should use the following clauses:

---Alternate I of 52.222-26 with the following fill in: "The contractor will not be obligated to develop the written affirmative action program required under the regulations implementing Executive Order 11246."

---Alternate I of 52.222-35 with the following fill in: "The contractor will not be obligated to develop the written affirmative action program required under the regulations implementing VEVRAA."

---Alternate I of 52.222-36 with the following fill in: "The contractor will not be obligated to develop the written affirmative action program required under the regulations implementing Section 503 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended."
