We hope you never get hurt at work. But should that happen, **Managed Care Advisors (MCA)** is here to help. MCA provides workers' compensation claims processing and medical case management services for the Department of Commerce and employs Claims Specialists to assist in claims related matters, including claims filing, compensation, and reimbursement. Should your injury cause you to lose time from work, MCA may also assign a Medical Case Manager (a Registered Nurse) to telephonically support you in your recovery. For All Injuries and Occupational Illnesses:

- 1. If it is an emergency, call 911 immediately.
- 2. Seek medical attention or first aid, as necessary.
- 3. Notify your supervisor immediately
- 4. Using ECOMP, file an <u>OSHA-301</u>. DOC now uses <u>ECOMP</u> for the electronic submission of claim forms.
- If you wish to submit a claim for Worker's Compensation, file a CA-1 or CA-2 via <u>ECOMP</u>, the Department of Labor's online claims filing portal.
- 6. Managed Care Advisors (MCA) will work closely with you, your supervisor and the Department of Labor to ensure that your claim is processed correctly and in a timely manner.
- 7. If your injury causes you to miss work, contact MCA to determine if Continuation of Pay benefits are authorized for your claim.
