# 21st Century Integrated Digital Experience Act - Report to Congress on Modernizing Agency Websites and Digital Services

As required by section 3(b)(2) of Public Law 115-336,<sup>1</sup> the 21st Century Integrated Digital Experience Act (21st Century IDEA), this report includes a list of key websites and digital services operated by the U.S. Department of Commerce (DOC) that have been prioritized and targeted for modernization.

#### **Background**

The 21st Century IDEA requires each federal executive branch agency to provide a prioritized list of the agency's "most-viewed or ... otherwise important" public websites and digital services as part of compliance requirements with section 3(a) of the law, and to provide an estimation of the cost and schedule to modernize those sites and services in need of modernization.

Public PAIR (http://portal.uspto.gov/pair/PublicPair)		NLT 9/30/2022; Note: The PAIR capability was established in early 2000s to replace people's need to come to USPTO in Virginia to get access to the complete application file wrapper. From the early 2000s to date we have added more data and capabilities for the public to access, however the architecture has not changed. This architecture was not established for large data miners. For the government Open Data program, the USPTO stood up PEDS (Patent Examination Data System) which has a subset of the PAIR data and capabilities. The PEDS architecture supports large data miners. The USPTO current replacement approach to Public PAIR is for PEDS and Patent Center to replace that system. The current schedule for that ongoing effort calls for moving all of Public PAIR to the new systems in FY22.

<sup>\*</sup>The figures listed above are rough order of magnitude estimates that the Department is in the process of reviewing and validating. These figures are included indicate the anticipated level of effort and resources that would be needed to modernize each site and are not intended as a request for funding or a commitment by the Department of Commerce to obligate such sums.
