I hereby delegate the authority granted to me by Under Secretary of Commerce for Oceans and Atmosphere through Section 111 of the Consolidated and Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 2015, Pub. L. No. 113-235, 128 Stat. 2130, Div B, Title I, to waive the requirement for bonds under 40 U.S.C. 3131 with respect to contracts for the construction, alteration or repair of vessels, regardless of the terms of contracts as to payment or title, when the contract is made under the Coast and Geodetic Survey Act of 1947 (33 U.S.C. 883a et seq.). Waivers will not be exercised for repair or construction of NOAA's fleet of research and survey vessels until regulations are promulgated to specify criteria under which waiver authority may be used. This authority may not be further delegated.


