5. Summary: CAM 1307.1 has been revised to incorporate significant revisions, to include the following:

- Exempts the requirement for a written acquisition plan for:
 1) fixed-price orders issued under DOC-issued indefinite delivery vehicles;
 2) real property leasehold agreements;
 3) utility services;
 and
 4) interagency acquisitions where DOC is the requesting agency.
- Implements the use of a streamlined acquisition plan format for fixed price acquisitions at \$10M up to \$75M.
- Replaces references to the former advanced acquisition forecast system, Commerce Business Opportunities Tool with the PRISM Advanced Acquisition Planning Module
- Establishes acquisition plan post approval requirements.
- Necessary updates and administrative changes.
