

## **Resources and Tools**

- Dynamic Small Business Search (DSBS) Search SBA's <u>DSBS.gov</u> by NAICS to find firms to qualified to meet agency requirements. The DSBS uses keywords, so users can search for specific products and services.
- Procurement Equity Tool A new procurement equity tool has been developed to improve agencies' analytic capability to find potential entities registered in System of Award Management (SAM) that could compete in an agency competition, in turn helping to diversify the supplier base.
- **Supplier Base Dashboard** This is a <u>tool</u> for the public and agency managers to track the size of the supplier base and the mix of new entrants, recent entrants, and established vendors in the supplier base using the definitions above.
- **Periodic Table of Acquisition Innovations -** Use innovative buying practices, such as those showcased on the <u>Periodic Table of Acquisition Innovations</u>, that have been demonstrated to reduce barriers and increase small businesses participation, such as virtual industry days, virtual requirements development, video proposals, and remote technical demonstrations.

## **Helpful Hints**

- Focus on understanding each DOC bureau and their separate missions.
- Participate in Market Research "Rule of Two".
  - If two (2) highly qualified vendors display capabilities to meet the needs, then small and socio-economic small business set-aside opportunities can be encouraged and supported.
- Do your homework on small or socio-economic categories that bureaus are not meeting.
- Focus on ensuring that the capabilities and core competencies align with the bureau that you would like to pursue opportunities with.



#### **Best Practices**

- Register to Do Business with the Government Ensure that your company is registered in the System of Award Management (SAM).
- Obtain Certifications Learn about certifications that are required through the Small Business Administration (SBA).
- Government-wide Vehicles Apply to get on government-wide contract vehicles such as General Services Administration (GSA) schedules, and NASA SEWP.
- Engagement and Meaningful Exchanges Make the Government aware of your capabilities and core competencies by responding to Request for Information (RFI), Sources Sought, and Special Notices, and market research information.
- Respond to Draft Solicitations Provide initial feedback to the Government on overly restrictive requirements, barriers to competition, or any areas of confusion that may cause you to be unable to respond.

• On the SBA Scorecard, Department of Commerce has received an A+ for seven consecutive fiscal years. The Scorecard is an assessment of DOC's achievement in reaching small business and socio-economic contracting goals, including categories such as womenowned small businesses, small disadvantaged businesses, service-disabled veteran-owned small businesses, and small businesses located in Historically Underutilized Business Zones (HUB Zones). In FY 2022, DOC awarded over \$2 billion dollars to small and socio-economic small business concerns.

Advancing racial equity and support for underserved communities: In accordance Executive Order (EO)
13985, the Department of Commerce will continue to focus on advancing racial equity and support for
underserved communities. Office of Management and Budget (OMB) memo 22-03, the President directed
agencies to make Federal contracting and procurement opportunities more readily available and to
remove barriers faced by underserved individuals and communities.

#### MBDA Engagement

- Connect departmental buying offices with the Minority Business Development Agency to leverage their networks to advertise our procurement opportunities.
- Promote MBDA's Federal Procurement Center to assist new and existing minority businesses in competing for Commerce procurements.
