## ETHICS AT A GLANCE POST-EMPLOYMENT RESTRICTIONS

After leaving Federal service former Government employees are subject to some restrictions on their activities, mostly limiting contacting the Government on behalf of others. The restrictions vary based on the employee's position and pay level.

## IN ADDITION:

- all employees are barred from receiving payments for representational activities of others (such as partners) before the Federal Government during a period the employee was in Federal service
- attorneys must comply with bar rules.

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
